

# After School Basketball Policy

After school basketball provides children the opportunity to participate in a team sport in a friendly and supported manner. It also gives other members of the Seville Primary School community an opportunity to volunteer and be part of the community.

## Purpose

- To provide Seville Primary School students the opportunity to play in an after school basketball competition and represent Seville Primary School.
- To provide the expectations and guidelines for participation the after school basketball program.

## Implementation

- Seville Primary School After School Basketball has a strict policy regarding sportsmanship and Codes of Conduct. These apply to players, coaches, scorers, parents and all spectators. This Code of Conduct is available at [www.kilsythbasketball.com.au](http://www.kilsythbasketball.com.au).
- Matches will be played at the Kilsyth and/or Lilydale Basketball stadiums with match times beginning between 4.00pm and 6.20pm on Weeknights.
- The school charges \$20 per child registration for each semester. This fee includes the team registration fee for one season, team training basketballs, end of season awards and uniform hire. A notice will be issued on Compass, with payment required by the due date. In order for your child to be selected for a team, you must have paid the fee by the due date.
- A weekly fee, usually around \$5, is also charged to cover the cost of the team sheet. Entry fee to the stadium is charged by the Kilsyth Basketball Club.
- The Kilsyth Basketball Club organises all fixtures and venues, with this in mind fixtures will be distributed as soon as possible however it is preferred that you check fixtures on the Kilsyth Basketball website at: [www.kilsythbasketball.com.au](http://www.kilsythbasketball.com.au) or download the relevant app.
- We rely on volunteers to allow our students to play in this competition, including coaches and team managers. All volunteers are required to have a current Working with Children Check.
- It is expected that once you commit to a Seville Primary Basketball team that your child plays the entire season. It is very difficult for coaches and team managers when players quit mid season. We do have two seasons per year, season 1 runs in term one and two, whilst season 2 runs term 3 and 4 so it is expected that once committed to a team you see out the season.
