

Dress Code - Uniform & Free Dress

The following items represent the Seville Primary School uniform:

Standard Uniform

Item	Details
Plain Navy Blue Pants	No denim and no tight fitting leggings. Pants appropriate for school activities, including Physical Education, are to be worn.
Plain Navy Blue short and long sleeved polos	With or without school logo
Plain Navy Blue windcheater or bomber jacket	With or without school logo
Please note: At least one top with school logo is required for each child	
Blue and White checked girls summer dresses	Navy bike shorts may be worn underneath dresses.
Plain Navy Blue Shorts	Short length appropriate for school activities, including Physical Education, are to be worn.
Socks that are visible	White, black navy or branding covered.
Shoes	Closed in and appropriate for all school activities including sport and Physical Education.
Hair accessories	Neutral or school colours.
Sun Smart approved plain Navy Blue hats	Must be worn in Term One and Term Four
Plain Navy Blue beanies	With or without school logo may be worn in terms 2 and 3.

Jewellery/Cosmetics

Item	Details
Jewellery	Stud earrings and sleepers worn in the ears, plus watches and activity tracker are the only acceptable jewellery. No necklaces allowed (under special circumstances allowed)
Hair colours	Extreme hair colours (eg: green, pink or purple rinses) and/or extreme hairstyles are not permitted.
Cosmetics	Other than clear nail polish, cosmetics may not be worn at school, including fake nails.

Free Dress

On days of “**Free Dress**” or “**Out of Uniform**” activities and events the following also applies:

- Clothing must be modest in nature including length of skirts and shorts, the neckline on tops and no bare midriffs.
- According to our Sun Smart policy, no singlet or strappy tops/dresses to be worn. Sun Smart hats must be worn during Term 1 and 4.

- During Crazy Hair Days, or the equivalent, extreme, non-permanent hair colours (eg: green, pink or purple rinses) and/or extreme non-permanent hairstyles are permitted.
- Other than clear nail polish, cosmetics may not be worn at school—except as part of costumes for “Free Dress” days.
- Shoes should be closed in and appropriate for all school activities including sport and Physical Education.

This document must be read alongside the Seville Primary School Student Dress Code Policy.
