## Book Packs

Book Packs are available to purchase through Ross Office Supplies and consist of *Essential Items*\* your child will require in the classroom and *Required Items* for additional resources. *Required Items* may be substituted with your own equivalent product but must be sent in with your child on the first day of school.

**\*NOTE:** It is our recommendation that all *Essential Items* be purchased through Ross Office Supplies to ensure all students are using the same products to assist with class organisation.
